- An ***in-school playwriting workshop*** with a City Theatre Teaching Artist for a total of 20 hours.
- Attendance to the 1 day ***Teacher Institute*** at City Theatre.
- A ***field trip*** for your students to attend the annual ***Young Playwrights Festival***.
- Six ***professional development workshops*** held in conjunction with the ***six main season shows*** at City Theatre. Tickets for these shows are included. (Teachers may also purchase a companion ticket package for 50% off the regular price.)
- An additional school field trip to attend a ***student matinee performance*** at City Theatre (if age-appropriate).
- ***Complimentary meals*** are provided with all workshops.
- Bus transportation and substitute teachers costs are also covered by City Theatre.

As a program participant, classroom teachers are expected to comply with the following:

- Teachers must address and **complete all evaluation materials** provided to them by program evaluators from Allegheny Intermediate Unit's Evaluation Team. This includes, but is not limited to, online surveys, lesson plan samples, and journal prompts relating to the performances and professional development workshops. All materials are due by the end of the school year.
- **Students will be asked to fill out a brief online survey** detailing their experience at the Young Playwrights Festival and/or another student matinee at City Theatre. Students will also be asked to fill out an online survey at the end of the Young Playwrights Program.
- **Teachers MUST attend a minimum of 4 out of 6 professional development workshops/performances** at City Theatre over the course of the year. (These dates are all set at the beginning of the school year).
- Although not required, City Theatre strongly encourages your students to **submit their original one-act plays into City Theatre's Annual Young Playwrights Contest** (deadline March 31st).
